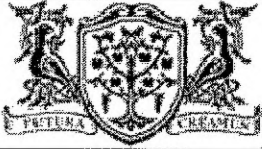

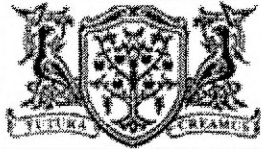

It was a sunny, warm summer day in the middle of June. The clear sky and fresh air were creating a relaxing atmosphere of joy and carelessness.
