- Lack of participation (zoom)
- Should learn independently
- · Lack of self-discipline
- · More of distractions while online learning
- Reduced social skills
- (pros) Improve searching skills and sharing resource
- · (pros) new online learning system is possible


# Environment


- · Lack of devices
- Weak Wi-fi connection
- Lack of skills using technologies (of students and teachers)
- · Lack of changes of exchange their perspective
- · Increased abusing at home
- · (pros) Increased wi-fi environment


# To researchers


- · Problem with conducting research
  - · Hard to find research place/field
  - · Many had to change their research topics
  - · Qualitative research is nearly unavailable
  - · Data collection methods have reduced
  - (pros) Quantitative study is much easier than before pandemic
  - (pros) Online conferences made learning more convenient and helping to save participation costs
- Limitation of using library
  - · Online library resources are limited
  - (solution) Korea's universities use walk-through system
  - (solution) China's universities use the VPN offering huge web database of electric books and references
- Internship opportunities are reduced
  - Teacher candidates cannot have chance to enter the classroom


