Please note that following the results of the Conference, it is planned to publish **a collection of articles and abstracts** with placement in *the RSCI*. Applications for publications in the collection are accepted until September 20, 2021 (inclusive). The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select and edit the submitted works for inclusion in the collection, as well as to verify authorship. The content of the materials is not subject to editing and modification.

**Basic requirements for the publication of articles:**

- articles and abstracts of no more than 11,000 characters with spaces are accepted for consideration;
- articles and abstracts should include practice-oriented solutions (proposals, recommendations) and be devoted to the topic of the Conference, taking into account the stated key areas;
- the percentage of borrowings can not exceed 25% of the volume of the text ;  
Times New Roman font, size 12, line spacing 1.5; A4 page format, margins at the top, right, left-2 cm, bottom-2 cm, without extra space characters, page numbers are not put down, links in square brackets in the text, at the end of the article: literature (no more than 6 sources);
- at the beginning of the material, the following should be indicated: the name, Surname, First Name and Patronymic of the author (or authors – no more than 2 people), place of work/study (subject of the Russian Federation, city or locality), position (indicating the decrypted name of the organization), scientific degree, abstract of up to 4 lines (TimesNewRoman font, size 12, italics, line spacing 1.5) in English and Russian.
- the material must be sent no later than the deadline and issued in accordance with the established requirements.
