## Britain

 1776 in the war of 1812, there was a new literary self-confidence and a new sense of national identity that some have described as "literary nationalism". Writers such asWashington Irving (in his short stories "Rip Van Winkle" and The Legend of Sleepy Hollow) and James Fenimore Cooper (in The Last of the Mohicans) had begun to pioneer American subjects in a distinctive $\quad$ American voice.

But it was Edgar Allan Poe, born 1809, who
signals the beginning of what would become a great Anglo-American literary dialogue. As well as being the first American writer to attempt living $\quad$ exclusively by his pen, he is also the archetype of the romantic artist. His $\begin{aligned} & \text { allure }\end{aligned}$ nomadic , boho style and tortured, exigent career continue to exercise a powerful allure on any young American writers who see themselves as outsiders.
